### Final Revolutionary War Pension Payment Vouchers: Delaware.

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These are the final pension payments for veterans of the Revolutionary War who resided in Delaware as well as one voucher for an 1812 veteran. If money was owned a pensioner at his or her death, the widow or heirs could apply for the arrears due them. If they did file such a request, there is only a last rather than a final payment. The records are arranged in alphabetical order by the name of the pensioner.

The table of contents lists the names of pensioners, spouses, and heirs. Dates of death of the pensioners, and names of attorneys, administrators, executors, may also be given.

A file may contain the name of the pensioner's spouse, the pensioner's county of residence as well as previous places of residence, military service including rank and unit, the act of Congress covering the claim, the amount of the pension, the amount of the final payment. In some files there may be more than one final payment record because the amount of the claim could have been miscalculated or the claim was paid out in installments rather than in a lump sum.

Men born between 28 April 1877 and 16 February 1897 were required to register. The cards are filed in a single alphabet for the state. The military needed men with construction skills; they were not liable for military service. Unlike other World War II draft registration records, these are open to the public. The form gives the name of the registrant, his place of residence, mailing address, telephone number, age, place and date of birth, name and address of someone who would always know his whereabouts, and signature.

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These records show the dates of establishment and discontinuance of post offices, their changes of name, and the names of and appointment dates for their postmasters and postmistresses. The names of post offices to which mail from discontinued offices was sent begins in 1870.

The records are arranged by state or territory, thereunder alphabetically by name of county (or district or parish as relevant), and thereunder by name of post office.
