Entries with the letter “D” or “DX” preceding a reel number refers to a delayed birth record. An unnamed infant will be indexed under the surname with the forename blank. Beginning with 1902 an unnamed infant was indexed under his or her father’s forename with an “F” or “M” as the middle initial indicating a female or male respectively.
