The index cards in many cases are the only record that survives. They abstract the information found on the original passenger manifest. The passengers may have arrived by boat or by train through substations along the Canadian border from the states of Maine to Washington.

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There are two types of records included in this series. One consists of traditional passenger lists on standard forms and monthly lists of aliens crossing the border on trains. The monthly lists are arranged by month, thereunder by name of port, and thereunder by railway. In 1895 the immigrant gave his or her name in full, literacy, last residence, and whether he or she had ever been in prison, an almshouse, or supported by charity. Beginning in 1906 the immigrant's physical description, place of birth including the country and city or town, and whether he or she was an anarchist. In 1924 the immigrant had to indicate if he or she could read and write and in what language.

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The manifests give the name of the ship, the port of embarkation, and the date of sailing. The manifests indicate if the person is a nonimmigrant and if he or she disembarked in Victoria, British Columbia. The vessels primarily came from Australia, Hawaii, Japan, New Zealand, and the Philippines.

This series of records consists of pay rolls, tables, orders and receipts, and accounts of public property. They include name, rank, dates of service, and wages due. Sometimes promotions, discharges, resignations, prisoners of war, and death are noted. John E. Goodrich's *Rolls of the Soldiers in the Revolutionary War*, 1775 to 1783 provides a nominal index.
