This is a transcript of the 1852 state census of California prepared by the Daughters of the American Revolution.

The California Constitution of 1849 required the 1852 census. The 1850 census of California did not record the residents of three of the twenty-seven counties, Contra Costa, San Francisco, and Santa Clara. They represented a substantial portion of the population in the state at that time. The census is similar to the federal census of 1852. Instead of the estimate of property value, the previous residence of each individual is recorded. There are thirteen volumes, each with its own index. There is no consolidated index. The typescript copy does not follow the sequence in the original records so it is extremely difficult to locate the corresponding entry in the original. This transcript does not include the numerous Chinese residents. Other omissions include entries that were too difficult to read.

There are over 94,000 index card to aliens and citizens arriving at the towns at the mouth of the Los Angeles River.

Form 548 and 548-B give the person's name, age, sex, marital status, place of nativity, physical description, occupation, citizenship, race, ability to read and write and in what language, place of last permanent residence, port and date of arrival, destination, purpose for entering the U.S., intention of becoming a U.S. citizen, head tax status, and previous citizenships. In addition the names of persons accompanying the alien and the name and address of the alien's nearest relative or friend whom the alien intended to join, and the name and address of the alien's nearest relative or friend in the country of his or her origin. Past dates and places of residence are listed for aliens who had previously been in the country.

Form 521 includes the person's name, sex, age, place of nativity, country of citizenship, home address, and the names of any accompanying children under the age of 16. The alien's occupation, destination in the U.S., name of the person to whom he or she was destined, the intended length of any stay were recorded. Both aliens and citizens completed this form.

Lastly there is a numbered form that includes the person's photograph, name, country of citizenship, place of nativity, father's and mother's place of nativity, naturalization information, age on his or her last birthday (*e.g.*, age 32 on 3 May 1919), height, name and date of arrival of vessel, vessel flag (such as U.S. registry), physical marks or peculiarities, complexion, and hair and eye color.

Form 685, Seaman's Identification Card, includes the person's photograph, name, age on his last birthday, nationality, and marks such as scars and tattoos.



Following statehood in 1850, California provided for the establishment of militia units to protect the citizens from Indian depredations. At that time most of the population was in the northern and central parts of the state so most of their units were from the same area. Attendance was usually semiannually. During the Civil War many of the units were taken into Federal service. The California National Guard replaced the militia system in 1866.

There are about 71,000 names in the index. Perhaps they represent some 35,000 different individuals. Nominal duplications would indicate internal migration within the state and promotions in rank.

The index consists of a number of fields following the name of the militiaman. The date is either that of his being mustered into the service or the date the unit was mustered into state service. The county code consists of a two or three letter abbreviation of the unit followed by two number2 indicating the unit with the county. The "certdate" or certification date column fixes the time a person was in a given locality and date of the original muster roll.

The last two fiche are the unit summaries. They are listed alphabetically by county code and thereunder by the part of the unit.

Applications for naturalizations 1879–1903 contain the date, name, place of residence, and nativity of the applicant as well as the names and residences of the witnesses. For San Francisco for the years 1855–1912, the index to certificates of citizenship give the date, name, and nativity of the applicant, and the volume and page number where it was recorded. The lists are alphabetical. The index to declarations of intent, 1851–1904, gives the applicant's name, date, and the volume and page where it was recorded. The index to naturalizations for 1853–1867 gives the name of the applicant, nativity, date of naturalization, and the court. There is also a space for remarks. The index to certificates of naturalization 1854–1905 has recorded minutes, the record number, and the volume and page where the record can be found. The alphabetical index to declarations of intentions and petitions of naturalization for the years 1906–1919 gives the applicant's forename and surname and the book and page where the declaration and the petition are recorded. The index to declarations of intent and petitions for 1920–1928 is listed alphabetically.

In 1866 California enacted a voter registration law in order to deal with voter fraud. The Great Registers of Voters started the next year and include the registrant's name, age, and place of birth. For foreign-born voters the place of naturalization and the court of record conferring the citizenship are also given.

This work is based on the California Great Register of 1872, which is the earliest year for which there are lists for most counties. The author used 1873 or 1875 lists for the counties without an 1872 register. Of the 184,157 voters in 1872, 61,691 were foreign born. The lure of the Gold Rush had brought people from Europe, Asia, Africa, and South America.

Each entry shows the person's name, age, country of birth, date and place of naturalization, court of record (or remarks), year of registration, year of register (i.e., 1872, 1873, or 1875), and county of residence. The author omitted occupations that would appear in the original records.
