This 556-page petition contains the signatures of 21,169 native Hawaiians who protested the proposed annexation of Hawaii in 1897. The signatories represented more than half of the native population. They were from all seven islands. There were 10,378 males and 10,891 females who signed. In addition to the petition itself there are Senate documents showing certification and receipt of the collective petition and Lorin Thurston's report on it.
