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More than 43,000 cards are in this index. Two forms were used. Form 629 contains the person's name, age, sex, marital status, race, occupation, ability to read and write, last place of residence, destination, and port and date of arrival. It also provides the names of person and the amount of money accompanying the alien. The manifest number is to be used to locate the manifest containing additional information about the person.

Form 621 includes the person's name, age, sex, nationality, race, last place of residence, destination, date and port of arrival, and status as immigrant or nonimmigrant. It also had a B.S.I. number [Board of Special Inquiry]. The number to the right of the person's sex is the actual manifest number, which, along with the date, to be used in locating the record in *Permanent and Statistical Manifests of Alien Arrivals at Douglas Arizona, September 10, 1906–October 10, 1955*.

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The Confederate Territory of Arizona encompassed the present states of Arizona and New Mexico, and its capital was Mesilla. The Confederates occupied the federal forts at Albuquerque, Santa Fe, and Tucson at the outset of the war. The three independent Arizona companies organized in 1861 became Herbert's Battalion, Arizona Cavalry in 1862. Texans also operated in the territory as the "Arizona Brigade." Union forces reoccupied the Territory of Arizona in 1862, and by May 1863 the Confederate battalion was broken up. Most of the officers and men were subsequently absorbed in organizations from Texas.

The compiled service records are in alphabetical order and consist of card abstracts from muster rolls, returns, payrolls, appointment books, hospital registers, Union prison registers and rolls, parole rolls, inspection reports, and original personal papers.

The records are indexed in *The Roster of Confederate Soldiers* 1861–1865, R973.742/C735R/1995.

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These are the commissions from the sheriff's office in Cochise County to deputy sheriffs during the trouble in the Warren District. The deputization papers contain the name of the individual sworn in by Sheriff Harry Wheeler in the bitter strike by the miners against Phelps Dodge Corporation and the Calumet and Arizona Mining Company. There were an estimated 1,200 miners who were "deported" to Columbus, New Mexico, on 12 July 1917.
